**MEMORANDUM**

**Please be aware the Jackson County Courthouse is closed to the general public until May 5, 2020 by the Jackson County Commissioners for all non-essential business.**

**While at this current time the Treasurer's office is considered at a non-essential nor time sensitive public operations. With the tax collection time quickly approaching and the 2019 pay 2020 tax bills are scheduled to be mailed out April 8<sup>th</sup>. To help keep our community safe and to slow the spread and exposure to the COVID-19, the Jackson County Treasurer's office is encouraging everyone to pay taxes through the following options.**

- 1. USPS Mail delivery.**
- 2. The drop box located on the back entrance location of the Historic Courthouse.**
- 3. Our on-line collections with credit card or debit card by visiting our county web site [www.jacksoncounty.in.gov](http://www.jacksoncounty.in.gov) under the Treasurer's page and following the links or by visiting the Freedom pay site at [www.jackson-tax.net](http://www.jackson-tax.net). Please note there will be a fee for using this option charged by the vendor. NOT Jackson County.**

**At this time we are not able to offer The Peoples Bank as an option for drop off and/ or collection. The Medora State Bank is still allowing drop off and collections. This is subject to change and we will advise as soon as we can on these options.**

**Again, as a reminder, Property taxes are due May 11, 2020 for the Spring installment and November 10, 2020 for the Fall installment.**

**While I am working diligently on additional options at this time I must encourage that options listed above be utilized.**
